Garden Recipe

CALABACITAS *Enjoy this traditional Southwestern dish of sautéed summer squash, onions, corn, and peppers as a side or as a vegetarian filling for tacos.*



- 1 medium onion, chopped
 - 1 poblano or Anaheim (sometimes called Hatch's) chile pepper, seeded and diced
 - 2 cups diced zucchini
 - 2 cups corn* (fresh off the cob or frozen)
 - ½ teaspoon salt
 - 1 tablespoon chopped fresh oregano
 - 2 tablespoons chopped fresh cilantro, (optional)
1. Heat olive oil in a large skillet over medium heat.
 2. Add onion and chile peppers; cook, stirring, until soft, about 4 minutes.
 3. Add zucchini, corn, oregano, and salt; cover and cook, stirring once or twice, until tender, about 3 minutes.
 4. Remove from the heat and stir in cilantro (if using).

* *If you prefer to make this dish without corn you can substitute another summer squash or beans in place of the corn.*
