• Work on the Tower Parapets has begun! The mortar and roof repair on the church tower began on March 8 and we expect this beginning stage of work to last around 2 weeks. A lift is required for the work and will be parked on Fillmore Street in the ADA accessible parking spot. Unfortunately there is not another place to store the lift while this work is being done but the ADA parking will continue to remain available on 11th Avenue. If you come by church during the weekdays you will probably see the



repair men and women at work and the front door will be closed off with caution tape both on the inside and outside of the building. We are delighted that this Phase 2 of repairs has begun. Funding for the work comes from the State Historical Fund and generous donations from our community friends at 1100 Fillmore!

- **Daylight Saving Time begins Sunday, March 12!** Remember to turn your clocks forward one hour on March 12 as we will spring forward into the time change (with one hour less of rest, so go to bed early if you can.)
