- January 28 Celebration of Capitol Heights' 128th Anniversary! Save the date for our upcoming Anniversary Celebration on Sunday, January 28 at 9:30 AM. The CHPC community was founded in 1896 as a tent community on York Street before building our current structure in 1911. Every fourth Sunday in January we mark the occasion with an anniversary celebration in our service and an honoring of the special ministry of friends among us with the "Walt and Janet Clark Honor in Ministry Award." This year the recipients of the award will be Don Dhonau and Nan Chouteau-Dhonau.
- First Thursday Dialogues: Our first Thursday dialogues continue in 2024 on zoom at 7PM every first Thursday of the month. In January we began looking at the work of **Kat Armas**, a Cuban American writer who holds a dual MDiv and MAT from Fuller Theological Seminary where she was awarded the Frederick Buechner Award for Excellence in writing. Together, our Thursday dialogue group are reading her second book just published in September 2023, Sacred Belonging: A 40 Day Devotional on the Liberating Heart of Scripture.

Drawing from personal narrative and Scripture, Armas highlights biblical passages that point toward decolonized themes centered on creation, wisdom, spirit, the body, and the feminine. *Sacred Belonging* helps us see how Scripture directs us to live a liberated faith, where we belong to God, the earth, and one another. Kat Armas also has a podcast, *The Protagonistas*, which centers the voices of Black, Indigenous, and other women of color in theological spaces.

Our next meeting will be on zoom on February 1st. If you would like to borrow the book or need help in accessing a copy please speak with Mark. The zoom link for the meeting will be in the open letter the Sunday prior to our meeting.
